No renewal of the Certificate within the limit will result in loss of eligibility for insurance coverage and appropriate legal action by the local self Government/Revenue Department. All officers of and above the rank of Station Officers of the Fire & Rescue Service Department will have the right to inspect the building on any day/time after serving 7 days notice to ensure that the installed systems are in good working condition.
